

**ENTRY AGREEMENT TO INSTALL, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN WHOLE HOUSE
WATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS**

This Entry Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into effective _____, 2013, by and between Pacific Gas and Electric Company ("PG&E") and _____, (hereafter referred to as "Owner") with regard to Owner's property, Assessor's Parcel Number _____, located at _____ in Hinkley, California (hereafter referred to as "Owner's Property").

1. Owner hereby gives PG&E, and its contractors and subcontractors, permission to enter Owner's Property as reasonably necessary, including Owner's home upon reasonable notice to Owner or a tenant and with Owner or a tenant providing access, throughout the term of this Agreement, to conduct all activities necessary to install, monitor, maintain, and, if elected by Owner, to remove:
 - a. an ion exchange treatment system that will treat the entire indoor, domestic water supply for Owner's home; and
 - b. undersink RO water treatment systems for drinking water supply at the identified sinks (cold water supply) within Owner's home.
2. PG&E will retain ownership of the entire WHW Treatment System for the duration of this Agreement. For the safety of residents and to ensure proper system maintenance and performance, structures housing the Treatment System components will be locked and only accessible to PG&E personnel or PG&E's contractors.
3. At the conclusion of this Agreement, which Agreement may be terminated by either party, PG&E will, at no cost to Owner:
 - a.) remove the WHW Treatment System and restore the original water supply configuration from Owner's well to Owner's home; or
 - b.) if requested by Owner, transfer ownership of the WHW Treatment System components to Owner. After transfer, all costs of ownership, including operation and maintenance, will be Owner's responsibility.
